"Lisa"

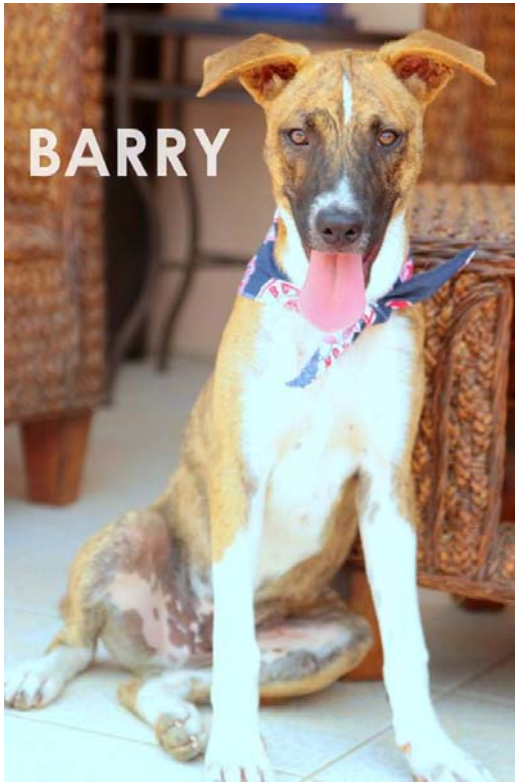
